

# Request for Qualifications and Quotations (RFQQ) for Project Technical Review Team

The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW), staff support for the Aquatic Species Restoration Program (ASRP) Steering Committee, is seeking qualifications and quotations to select members for a project technical review team (TRT), a group of independent experts available to provide periodic review and consultation on all projects submitted for ASRP funding, further referred to as CONSULTANTS for this RFQQ.

Implementing on the ground restoration, protection, and conservation projects are critical for ASRP success. To promote efficiency and certainty in this work, WDFW will utilize the project portfolio approach. Projects are vetted multiple times throughout project development to verify their technical merits, fit with ASRP goals, and inclusion on the project portfolio list.

WDFW seeks broad participation from technical experts to participate in these efforts with experience in aquatic habitat restoration, protection and conservation projects, and research. Participants may represent government, business, consultants, non-profit, academia, and other sectors. The TRT is independent in the sense that its members do not represent an agency or constituency, participates in an annual review concerning conflicts of interest and may be recused from project review based on relevant policy.
